INGREDIENTS

Oats, wheat, cereal byproducts, triticale, barley, lupins, molasses, vegetable oil, limestone, dicalcium phosphate, potassium chloride, salt, live yeast culture, organic chromium, mould inhibitor, vitamin E, KER vitamin/trace mineral premix.

Features and Benefits

Provides all the essential nutrients, vitamins and minerals for optimal health and fitness of equine athletes

High quality protein and amino acid balance to build and repair muscle tissue

Supplies highly digestible energy sources, including added fat, to maintain body condition and meet energy needs for peak performance

Contains high levels of the antioxidants Vitamin E and selenium for enhanced immune function and muscle recovery

High in B group vitamins to improve appetite, energy utilisation and red blood cell synthesis

Contains live yeast culture to enhance digestion and mineral absorption

Contains organic chromium to improve glucose metabolism, decrease lactic acid accumulation and reduce the severity of tying up

Contains added electrolytes to replace sweat losses

Premium blend of quality grains and ingredients used to maximise finished feed quality and palatability

Pelleting improves energy utilisation from grains and reduces waste of powdered minerals and vitamins

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Performax™ should be fed in conjunction with a minimum of 1% body weight of good quality roughage in the form of pasture, hay or chaff

Performax™ should be introduced slowly to the diet over 7 -10 days

The amount fed should be divided into at least two feeds daily, with a maximum of 3kg of Performax™ per feed

Reduce the amount of Performax™ fed on rest days

Supply a salt block to heavy sweating horses and extra electrolytes if required eg Equivit Restore

For horses prone to nervousness or tying up, use Pegasus Equibalance™ mixed with steam flaked barley or as the sole feed

Clean, fresh water should be available at all times

Feeding recommendations (kg/day)

Bodyweight	400kg	500kg	600kg
Light work	2.5-3.5	3.5-4.5	4-5
Moderate work	3.5-4.5	4.5-5.5	5.5-6.5
Heavy work	5-6	6-7.5	7-8

The above table is a guide only and the amount fed should be adjusted according to the horse's age, temperament, condition, bodyweight and workload.
