Layer Crumble

Layer Crumble is a nutritionally balanced crumble designed to be fed to layers from 17 weeks of age to end of lay. It is available as either a pellet or crumble.

Features	Benefits

NUTRITIONAL ANALYSIS

Crude Protein (min)	14.0%

INGREDIENT SELECTION

Lupins, peas, barley, oats, wheat, triticale, cereal byproducts, meatmeal, limesand, salt, methionine, carotene, vitamin/trace mineral premix.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Layer Crumble should be fed *ad lib* from about 17 weeks of age (1-2 weeks before point of lay) through to the end of lay.

Birds can be expected to eat about 120 g/day depending on weight and environmental conditions, especially heat.
